### Waiting for God

On Sunday, November 27, we begin the Advent journey, a journey that culminates in our celebration of the birth of our Savior and Lord, Jesus the Christ.

The first step we must take, ironically, is to simply wait. To seemingly do nothing at all and instead wait for God to make the first,

game-changing move. But, according to the scriptures, waiting is not a passive exercise. We assume a posture of openness so that we are capable of noticing God's movements in the world and in our lives. We invite the Spirit to move within us, filling us with hopeful expectation. In this sense, waiting on the Lord requires discipline. It's hard work!

So, as the people of God, we learn how to wait...

Below are a few verses from my favorite Psalm and a devotional thought by author, Macrina Wiederkehr, to hold our hand as we learn to wait.


