

Don't Be an Absentee: Voting, Voters' Rights, and Volunteering

Texas Voting Eligibility Requirements

- 17 years and 10 months of Age at Registration
- 18 Years old to vote
- United States Citizen
- Registered to Vote in the County where you live
- Vote in the county where you are registered
- Acceptable Identification

Acceptable Forms of Identification

- Driver license
- Temporary Visitor Card
- State of Texas Election Certificate
- License to Carry Handgun
- United States Uniformed Services
- Passport

Other Ways to Identify a Voter: Execute a Reasonable Impediment by presenting one of the following.

- Present a copy of government document with name, address and voter registration certificate
- Current Utility Bill
- Bank Statement
- Government Check
- Paycheck
- Certified domestic birth certificate
- Document confirming birth admissible in a court of law

Vote by Mail

- Eligibility
 - Over 65
 - Out of County during Early Voting and on Election Day
 - Have a disability, or illness
- Requires Absentee Ballot Application for each election
- Over 65 years automatically eligible

- Can apply once per year
- Must apply yearly
- Provide (twice) once on Absentee ballot application form and on ballot envelope used to return ballot
 - Driver license number
 - Last four digits of Social Security Number
- Risk of being rejected because of errors; can make corrections online
- Can be contacted by county via email to notify of eligibility to vote in person
- Voting in person requires surrender of absentee ballot

November 2024 Election Dates

Last day to register to vote	Monday, October 7, 2024
1 st day of early voting by personal appearance	Monday, October 21, 2024
Last day to apply for ballot by mail (received not postmarked)	Friday, October 25, 2024
Last day of Early Voting by personal appearance	Friday, November 1, 2024
Last Day to Receive Ballot by Mail	Tuesday, November 5, 2024 (Election Day) at 7:00 P.M. if carrier envelope is <u>not</u> post marked, OR Wednesday, November 6, 2024 (next day after Election Day at 5:00 p.m. if carrier envelope <u>is</u> post marked by 7:00 p.m. at the location of the Election on Election Day (unless overseas or military voter deadlines apply)
